

Program Overview

- An age appropriate curriculum specialized for each classroom designed to encourage discovery.
- Activities are based around weekly themes and Bible stories.
- Learning centers provide opportunities for hands-on reinforcement of concepts and skills.
- Learning objectives give focus in science, math, music, large and fine motor skills, as well as language and literacy.

- Art focus is on the process of creating rather than the final product.
- Music & Movement is done daily and children learn that movement and music can communicate messages.
- Sign language is part of our daily curriculum and is started in our 1's class. When ASL is used in combination with spoken language it enforces the learning of educational concepts such as ABC's, animals and other themes.
